##### **5. RESEARCH EXPERIENCE:**

- 2004 to 2005, practical experience in conducting and coordinating a baseline research study in a resource limited settings, that was aimed at describing and establishing the prevalence of factors which are associated with kidney complications in patients with diabetes, a non-communicable disease gaining high prevalence in developing countries. This was in view of recognizing that diabetes is becoming prevalent and these factors leading to kidney failure can be modified by appropriate interventions thus delaying and /or completely stopping the progression of the disease. Moreover, the treatment of kidney failure is very expensive in Kenya. The title was: -**“The prevalence of factors associated with chronic renal disease in patients with diabetes mellitus as seen at the Kenyatta National Hospital in Nairobi”**.
