Dr Eddy Geoffrey Mosoti Mogoia was born on 1st of January, 1960. He did his early schooling in Nyanza province before joining Mang'u High School in Central Kenya in 1979 for his high school. Dr Mogoia has been involved in teaching both undergraduate and postgraduate students Veterinary, Wildlife and Biomedical Technology courses and undertaking research and offering consultancy services in various areas in the livestock / animal health sector. He is also involved in supervision of undergraduate student projects, Masters and Doctorate students. He has carried out research and published many papers in various local and international journals, and presented more than 38 papers (authored by self and / or with colleagues) in various conferences / workshops. These presentations have been on anaesthesia, pain management, disaster preparedness and mitigation, veterinary education, animal welfare and livestock policy issues.
