## ✦ Issues dealing:

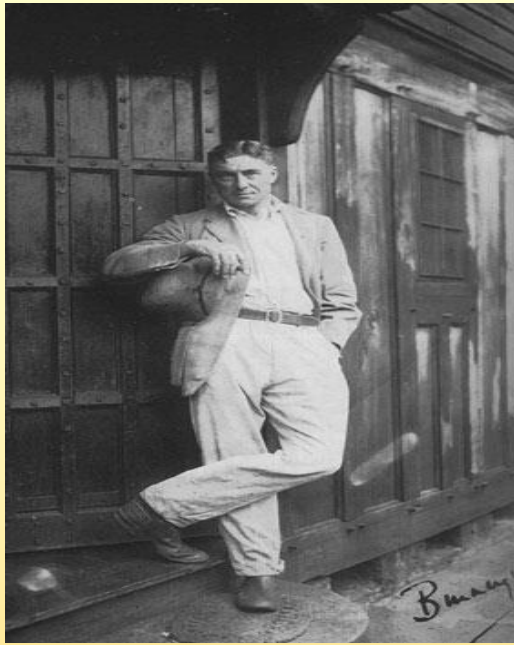
- 1) Institutional arrangement: (central govt, local govt. Nairobi metropolitan development ministry, provincial administration)
- 2) City level governance (executive, legislature & judiciary)
- 3) Party politics (ODM/PNU; political constituencies & wards; CDF/LATF)
- 4) Privatisation of space & services at the neighbourhood level
